

This is what your child will know exiting kindergarten...

- Write first and last name using uppercase and lowercase letters appropriately
- Recognize, name, and write all uppercase and lowercase letters
- Produce all letter sounds
- Demonstrate concepts of print (how a book works, front cover, back cover, title, where the story starts, punctuation marks, etc.)
- Retell a story in sequence with supporting details (beginning, middle, and end)
- Read the word wall words:

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- Identify sounds of words
- Hear and produce rhyming words

- Phonetically write 3 to 4 sentences on a topic (write words by the sounds you hear in the words)
- Count by 1's, 5's, and 10's to 110
- Knows simple addition and subtraction
- Identify and write any number from 0-100
- Name and identify 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional shapes (triangle, square, rectangle, circle, oval, rhombus, trapezoid, hexagon, cube, sphere, cylinder, cone, and rectangular prism)
- Understand and create graphs
- Follow a 4-5 step direction
- Engage in a task for approximately 20 minutes
- Complete work independently
